5. Active BPG Projects	Action
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<p>5.1 2010 Planting Activities Preparation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The next BPG planting day is Sunday 26 September corresponding to the best morning low tide in months for planting 800 <i>Juncus kraussii</i> (Shore Rush) and <i>Juncus pallidus</i> (Pale Rush). 9:00am start. • Sunday 22 August is proposed for a staking day at Ashfield Flats around the new EHPS planted area and where ever the mowing contractor has overreached. Yep, 9:00am again. • 11 July at Pickering Park Steve and Bronwyn from ToFB plus BPG Volunteers Steve, Greg, Natasha, Ruth and Maggie planted 1300 <i>Ficinia nodosa</i> (Knobby Club Rush) seedlings kindly arranged for by Steve and delivered by Bronwyn. It was all over in two hours using the new BPG Pottiputkis. Michael and Ally were also there to work but for a misunderstanding of the start time (it's always 9:00am!) and the efficiency of the crew finishing so fast. Unbelievably, it didn't really rain the whole two hours, but there have been good soaking rains since to water them in. • Steve used Ted's stencil to brand our 5 bright shiny new red No. 63 Pottiputkis with the BPG Wagtail logo. • As of 27 June pre-planting preparation at Ashfield Flats, including the area John Buxton suggested for assisting natural regeneration through weed control is complete. • On 11 June at Ashfield Flats Steve, Ted, Carlle, Ruth and Natasha met Kevin from DPI and Eric the Dingo Man to undertake the post hole trial preparation. We had a system worked out in no time, and in two hours had 106 holes dug and back filled with various combinations of soil amendments ready for the next stage, planting out the natives. 	
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<p>5.2 Teachers Environment Fund Grant:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On 21 July at Ashfield Flats 150 EHPS Pre-Primary, Year Three, Four, Six and Seven students, 9 teachers and 22 parents planted 350 native plants using BPG's 5 pottiputkis. • Ruth and Steve represented BPG, along with Maggie who with another EHPS teacher Maria organized the event. • Cr Don saved the day when BPG's key failed to open the access gate by getting a Ranger on the scene in minutes. • Eastern Community Reporter and Independent Express sent reporters and story was featured in both papers the following week.
