### **NATIVE TREE DECLINE in FOREST and WOODLAND of the SOUTH WEST**

Native tree decline is becoming alarmingly widespread across south-western Australia due to a range of factors including insect attack, pathogens and disease, water stress, pollutants, poor pruning methods and loss of understorey vegetation. Consequences of native tree decline and the subsequent death of native trees include loss of ecological and social values.

**Fees**  
**Full payment is to be made two weeks before the commencement of the seminar** unless otherwise negotiated with project manager. Payment is to be made by cheque or direct deposit payable to Green Skills Inc and sent to Green Skills with the Enrolment Form.

- Refunds**
1. A full refund is given if:
    - the participant is not given a place due to maximum numbers of participants for the seminar being exceeded;
